The Landry family and the rest of the Swamp People are part of this colorful and proud Cajun legacy, which boasts not only a flavorful cuisine, distinctive music and a vastly vibrant culture, but a deep and reverent appreciation for the land that has provided them refuge and a way of life. Today, in America's largest swamp — a million acres of inhospitable bayous, marshes and wetlands known as the Atchafalaya Basin — the Swamp People continue to carry on their ancestors' trades and traditions living off of the swamp's bountiful resources, borrowing and giving back to the swampland that they call home, always mindful to hunt and fish only what they need and to not let anything go to waste.

The Swamp People's amazing story is not only about carrying on this rich Cajun tradition of self-reliance and local sourcing, but it is about their commitment to their families, their communities and their beloved land. Seeking to maintain this way of life, the Swamp People play an important role as environmentalists who are passionate and respectful of the environment that they have lived off of for generations, understanding that it is not only their home, but their future.
